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## COURSE OBJECTIVES

Interactive learning sessions that explore the role of food and music in international cultural relations. The seminar aims to equip students with analytical tools to understand how everyday cultural practices contribute to diplomacy, identity, and global cooperation. Designed for students from diverse academic backgrounds, the programme encourages critical reflection on intercultural dialogue, sustainability, and social transformation.

## LEARNING METHODOLOGIES

The seminar adopts a student-centered, interdisciplinary approach rooted in experiential learning. Activities include expert-led discussions, case study presentations, co-creative workshops, and interactive dialogues. This method supports the development of practical skills through observation, reflection, conceptual framing, and collaborative experimentation, with a strong emphasis on real-world cultural scenarios.
